

Purchase a ticket to ride on AirTrain from NJ TRANSIT or Amtrak at their train stations, ticket offices or ticketing machines. The AirTrain Newark fee will be included - one ticket does it all.

NJ TRANSIT trains that stop at the airport are designated by "EWR" on departure boards. You'll need to show the ticket to the conductor on the train, and to pass through the fare gate at Airport Station. Take the ticket with you when you leave the train.

Be sure to check the NJ TRANSIT or Amtrak train schedule, especially first and last train times weekdays, weekends and holidays. NJ TRANSIT service is not available between approximately 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.

‡Around the airport, AirTrain arrives and departs every three minutes from 5 a.m. to midnight and approximately every 15 minutes from midnight until 5 a.m. Between midnight and 5 a.m., AirTrain shuttle service travels between parking lot P2 and Terminal A, between Terminal A to parking lot P4, and between parking lot P4 and Airport Station. Passengers traveling from any of the terminals to the Airport Station or to rental cars/daily parking lots P2 and P3 will be required to transfer trains.

\*Contact PATH, NJ TRANSIT or Amtrak for information on discounted monthly tickets, 10-trip tickets and other special fares. All fares are subject to change. Children under 11 ride free on NJ TRANSIT.

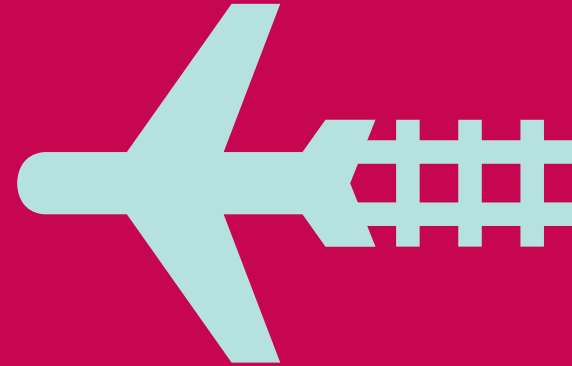

## Welcome to AirTrain Newark.

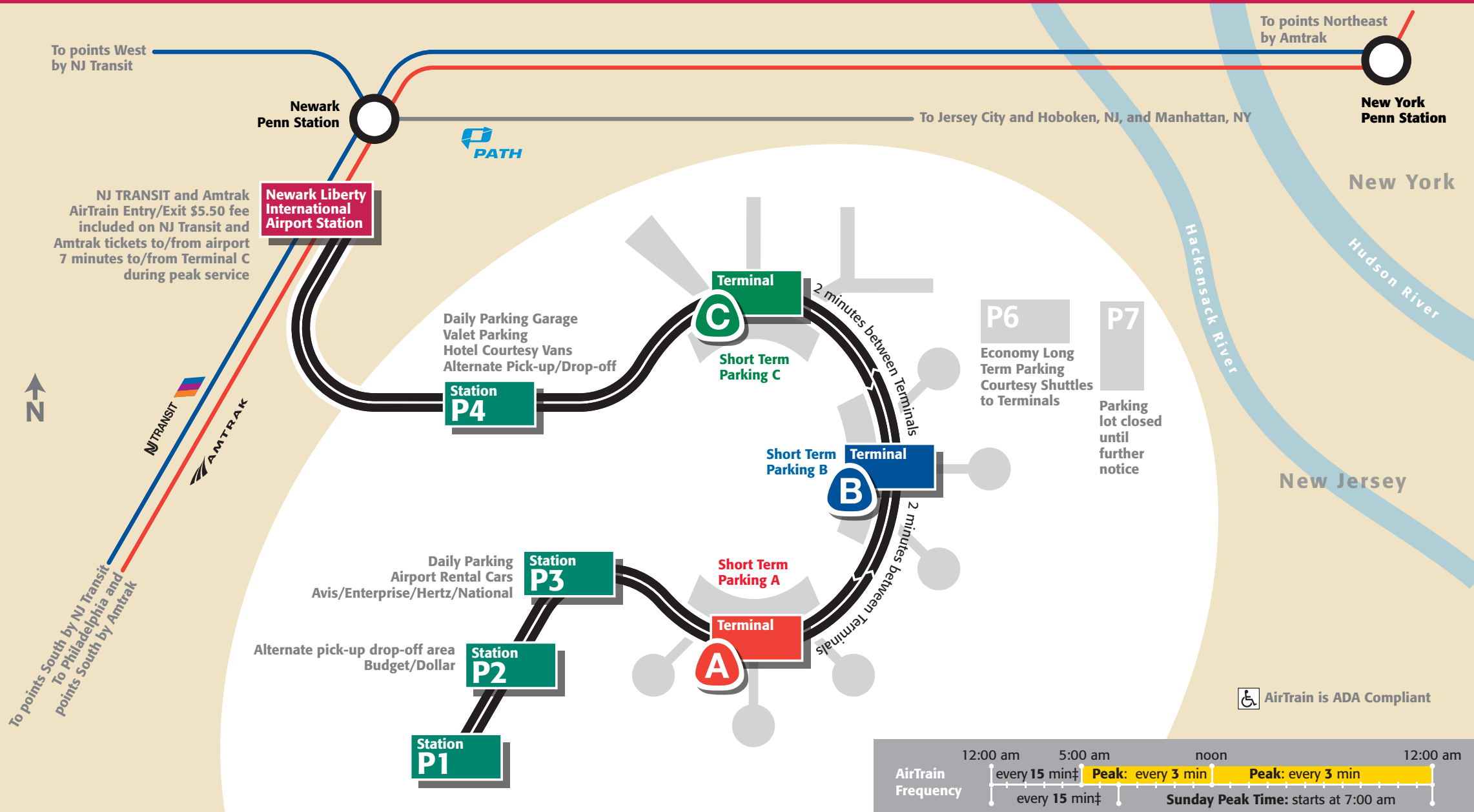
Traveling to and from Newark Liberty International Airport with AirTrain Newark is convenient and easy.

AirTrain Newark provides a connection to NJ TRANSIT, Amtrak, and PATH through one gateway: Newark Liberty International Airport Station.

If you're an arriving passenger at the airport, AirTrain is a low-cost way to connect to mass transit for travel to Manhattan and points north or to Philadelphia and points south.

The service is free for on-airport travel and makes frequent stops including airline terminals, parking lots, hotel shuttle areas and rental car facilities. Travel time is between seven and 11 minutes from Airport Station to your terminal. AirTrain Newark runs 24 hours a day, every day for on-airport travel.





### PATH Service to Newark Penn Station

PATH, a service of the Port Authority, is available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. Trains run frequently during most hours every day, but run at a reduced frequency during certain hours of the day.

### NJ TRANSIT Service to Airport Station

Weekdays, between 6 a.m. and 9 p.m., six NJ Transit trains arrive every hour at the airport station. Between 9 p.m. and midnight, four trains arrive every hour. Service is not available between approximately 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m.

Amtrak services on the Northeast Corridor run approximately every hour between Newark Liberty International Airport Station, Philadelphia and New York City. Some trains continue to, and originate from, Boston, providing service to Stamford and New Haven, CT, and intermediate points.
