TITLE: Request for Proposals for Situational Awareness Platform
Software and Integration Services for the World Trade Center Site

DESCRIPTION: The Port Authority of NY & NJ is seeking Request for Proposals (RFP) from qualified firms to furnish, install, integrate, configure, and maintain a Situational Awareness Platform Software (“SAPS”) system for the World Trade Center Site. The Authority requires a turnkey solution that will function effectively at rollout and provide scalability.

The SAPS system will provide a means to collect, correlate, and display information from various electronic systems that are either currently deployed or are in the process of being designed and constructed at the eleven (11) stakeholder buildings/facilities at the World Trade Center Site. The representative range of systems intended to be monitored by the SAPS include but are not limited to: access control, alarm point monitoring, video surveillance, fire alarm, building management systems, vertical transportation, digital intercom, radio communication, Chemical - Biological - Radiological and Nuclear (CBRN) detection and vehicle schedule systems. In addition to the ability to collect, correlate, and display information from these systems, of paramount importance in addition SAPS shall provide identity management capabilities. The identity management capability shall be fully integrated with the physical situation awareness function, so that a single sign-on, single web based Graphical User Interface (GUI) environment is achieved.
